

LEADER'S GUIDE FOR DVD-88C

Bare Board Defect Recognition

Bare Board Defect Recognition (DVD-88C) has been developed to provide assembly operators with the information they need to recognize the most common bare board defects. The following is a description of this IPC Training Certification program.

The program is divided into six sections – including an introduction; defects in the base material; solder mask problems; damage or contamination on gold fingers; damage to traces and lands; and marking defects.

The URL for these download materials is also printed on the face label of the DVD.

These training support materials include a thirty-question *examination* and a printable certificate for students that score 70% or better on the final test.

Below are our recommendations for how best to use the DVD and training materials to help insure that your students will pass the exam.

Review

After you *play* each section of the DVD, stop the video when appropriate and clarify and reinforce any information or specific requirements that are important to you.

When you complete each topic, you have the option of asking the *Review Questions* that are applicable to each section. In discussing each question, the group can develop a consensus answer. Or you can simply print out the questions and allow the students to answer them individually.

Test and Certificates

After you complete the DVD, you can give the students the *IPC Training Certification Test*. You may print as many copies of the *test* as necessary. Directions regarding how to take the test, how to mark answers, change answers, etc. are all provided on the first page of the test. Please review these directions with your students.

An *Answer Key* is also provided for grading the *test*. After you grade the tests, you may wish to return them to each student so they can review any incorrect answers.

A *color* version of an IPC *Training Certificate* is included on the DVD-88C download page. This .pdf certificate allows you to type in the names of all the students that pass the test - and print out individual color certificates. *Training Certificates* can be provided to students who obtain a passing grade of 70% (**21 correct answers**) or better on the final test.

CEUs

In order to assign *continuing education units* to each student... measure the total training time in reviewing DVD-88C, group discussion and testing. Each one-hour increment of training translates into 0.1 CEU. Therefore, if you spend 2 hours in classroom training and evaluation, each student would earn 0.2 CEU. You may need to provide written documentation for student CEU records.
